

Standard of Dress

All students are expected to adhere to common practice of modesty, cleanliness and neatness and to dress in such a manner as to contribute to the academic atmosphere. Any clothing, object, or writing on clothing that refers to alcohol, tobacco, drugs, gangs, sexual innuendos, foul language, or is otherwise controversial or disruptive to the educational process is prohibited.

FOOTWEAR

Footwear must be worn at all times. House slippers are not permitted.

ACCESSORIES

Students will not be permitted to carry blankets, pillows, and stuffed animals to class.

The school administration shall have the right to evaluate any clothing to determine its acceptability within the standard of dress. Administrators shall have the right to make an interpretation on the decency and appropriateness of any garment. All staff members are responsible for enforcing the dress code. Any student who is out of dress code during the school day will be required to change clothes.
